

The bulk of revenue for the month of September was from tables for the holiday gift fair, along with a couple of apple orders and the deposit from last year's Mabel's labels.

October will have increased revenue due to the apple fundraiser and spirit wear.

The only two expenses for September were the teacher discretionary funds and an accordion folder to keep the year's financial records organized.

We received notification that we were successful with the Gaming grant in the amount of \$4,120.00 and anticipate that we will receive the funds in October and will be reported on at the next meeting.

The chequing account balance on September 30th was \$6,848.55, leaving us with \$9,494.75 in available funds as of the end of September.

Jen was working on the annual Gaming report and discovered that there was a discrepancy for last year's records, she will call Gaming this week for instructions on correcting it and will complete the report for submission next week.
